# Did you know?

**Fact:** The Famee Furlane Toronto was created as a benevolence organization, with its home, the spirit of its members, the first 20 years of its life responded to individual and community needs, in addition to working towards preserving furlanitat. The Famee supported members who needed medical, financial or other assistance during the depths of the depression. By 1936 membership topped 200.

*Fact: The more than familiar mosaic* and terrazzo table in the front lobby of the Famee Furlane Toronto, was made for Pietro Rodaro, one of the founding members of the Famee Furlane, and gifted in payment for board owed. It was around this very table that the idea for the creation of organization was our given birth. No doubt a good "tai" or two was enjoyed. The table was eventually donated to the Famee by Pietro's descendants and restored by Aldo Mian. If you are wondering, ves, our own George Rodaro has a special connection to this table. Pietro Rodaro was George's great uncle. What impressive roots!
