SEPTEMBER'S WALK **INTO THE PAST...**

Who can ever forget May 7, 1976 and the destruction that ravaged a 8,547 square kilometre area and killing about 1000 people in our beloved Friuli. Immediately, its effects were far reaching and very emotional. Community members, Messrs. Del Medico, Di Luca, Muzzo, Zorzi and Francescut immediately formed a committee to spearhead relief efforts, involving both the Italian Canadian Benevolent Corporation and the Congress of Italo-Canadians. All came together to form the Friuli Relief Fund, under the leadership of non-Furlan, Dr. Leone. With the Famee Furlane at the heart of this operation, 1976 was the year that through this tragedy, spurred it into action, forging strong ties with a of Italian-Canadian institutions, all levels of Canadian government as well as Friuli Venezia Giulia and the Italian Republic. Doors to more expansion and its commitment to furlanitat opened. It was through its love of our homeland, with the influence of strong leadership and unwavering support from its community, that outreach efforts raised over \$4.5 million leading to the construction of hundreds of new homes. This tragedy not only reinforced and unified our community but also was the catalyst that in many ways allowed the Famee Furlane Toronto to be put "on the map with a well-deserved reputation for following through and getting things done"*


